Contestant Requirements:

Entry Fee \$100.00...**non-refundable**. Please make checks payable to "Bessie Smith Cultural Center."

All contestants are required to be in grades 9 thru 12.

All contestants are required to sell a minimum of \$500.00 in ads and/or tickets. Tickets are \$10.00 each. In addition, each participant will receive 2 free tickets.

Four judging categories: Casual wear, Talent Presentation, Evening Ensemble, and On-stage question. The Miss Bessie Smith winner will be the one with the highest cumulative score.

Miss Bessie Smith will receive a crown, trophy, roses, \$500 cash scholarship, sash and other gifts. Miss Bessie Smith will represent the Bessie Smith Cultural Center at selected exhibit openings and various community events throughout her year of service.

There will be a 1st and 2nd runner-up for Miss Bessie Smith each receiving a trophy and roses.

The Spirit of Bessie Smith Award will be the contestant that raises the most money, she will receive 10% of **HER** funds raised for future scholarship, and other gifts.

Casual Wear Winner will receive a trophy

Talent Winner will receive a trophy

Evening Ensemble combined with the On-Stage Question Winner will receive a trophy

All contestants will receive a T-shirt and participation trophy.

Talent	0 - 35 points
On-Stage question	0 - 20 points
Evening Ensemble	0 - 25 points
Total points	100

Each contestant's talent, casual wear and evening ensemble will be furnished by the contestant and her parent/guardians. Points will be given to each contestant's overall appearance, confidence, and sense of style that she brings to all categories.
